Graduate Student Support by New Faculty Members Award

Purpose:

The purpose of this award is to encourage new faculty members to undertake supervision of new full-time graduate students in keeping with Waterloo's vision for Graduate Expansion. On the recommendation of a new faculty member, the student will receive a \$5,500 award. *(This proposal is applicable to faculty members who started their appointments after May 1, 2005).*

Eligibility and Conditions:

- The new full-time faculty member must hold a professorial appointment or cross-appointment in a department with a graduate program and have been hired within the last two years.
- The faculty member must be eligible to supervise a graduate student who is working on a thesis.
- The maximum funds per faculty member are \$5,500, to be used exclusively to support one or more newly admitted full-time graduate students (preferably domestic) in term one or two of their graduate program.

Administration:

The Faculty Graduate Studies Office will receive a nomination (using the standard Awards Nomination Template Form) containing the information listed below from the department/unit, and will approve and forward it to the Graduate Studies Office (GSO) prior to the term of award for the student.

- Faculty member name and start date of their appointment
- Student name(s) and ID number(s)
- Start date (i.e. term) and value of the student award(s)

Following approval from the GSO, the award will be disbursed directly to a student's Waterloo account under the award name:
